Unresolved conflict stalls the change effort, stifles communication, and can negatively impact productivity. Managed well, disputes can create stronger connections, resilience, and increased capacity to deal with difficulty. When disputes are handled poorly, the effects can be far-reaching and costly.

In this, session participants will:

- Discover personal success practices and challenges in handling differences
- Practice key communications that prevent unnecessary conflict
- Learn how to keep the focus on what's important, not on competing fixed positions
- Understand how to intervene when there is conflict at work
- See how leaders can act as mediators to help staff solve issues
